Hello Friends, The months of April, May and June were quite satisfying for all of us here at Hockey India. After a fruitful start to the new year for Hockey India, our efforts started paying dividends as we were able to progress to the next stage of qualification for the Tokyo Olympics 2020.

Both, the Indian Men's Hockey Team and the Indian Women's Hockey team outclassed their oppositions in their respective FIH Men's and Women's Series Finals held in Bhubaneswar and Hiroshima respectively. Both the teams remained unbeaten in their conquests, with the Men's team defeating the likes of Russia, Poland, Uzbekistan, Japan and South Africa to win the FIH Men's Series Finals Bhubaneswar Odisha 2019. Whereas, the Women's team defeated Uruguay, Poland, Fiji, Chile and Japan on their way to win the FIH Women's Series Finals Hiroshima 2019.


Everyone at Hockey India is proud of the way the teams performed and I would also like to applaud the great efforts put in by the whole team of Hockey India in organizing the FIH Men's Series Finals Bhubaneswar Odisha 2019.


Domestically, we saw some amazing performances from our Sub-Junior level athletes who took part in the 9th Hockey India Sub-Junior National Championships (Men and Women) for both A and B Divisions. The coaching and performances at the Sub-Junior level will help in developing a core group of players for us to choose from, who can then be a part of our development squad as well as the Junior teams' set-up for the upcoming few years.

Internationally, all our four teams, Senior Men, Senior Women, Junior Men and Junior Women were involved in competition from April to June 2019. Firstly, it was our Senior Women's team who played and defeated Malaysia and Republic of Korea in their own back-yard in each of the two bilateral series. The Senior Men's team toured Australia to play a total of five matches against WA Thundersticks, Australia 'A' team and the Australian Senior Men's Hockey team. The Junior Women's team brought laurels to the country when they won the Cantor Fitzgerald U21 International 4-Nations Tournament held in Dublin, Ireland. The team also went for a tour of Belarus where they played their Senior, Junior and Development teams. Apart from our Senior teams participating in their respective FIH Series Finals, the Junior Men's team took part in the 8-Nations U-21 Invitational Tournament held in Madrid, Spain where they finished sixth.

The month of April - June also saw Hockey India organize more sessions of the Hockey India Coaching Education Pathway. After the successful completion of the FIH Academy - Hockey India Level 2 Technical Officials Course followed by the FIH Academy- Hockey India Level 2 Umpiring course, the FIH Academy Educator Course as well as the FIH Academy Level 1 Coaching Course presented by Mike Joyce, Executive Director - The Hockey Foundation and FIH Development Director, was successfully completed in the city of Bhubaneswar.

Overall, it has been a great second quarter of 2019 for all of us here at Hockey India, but it only paves way for us to excel in our endeavours, and keep working towards our aim of revolutionizing hockey.

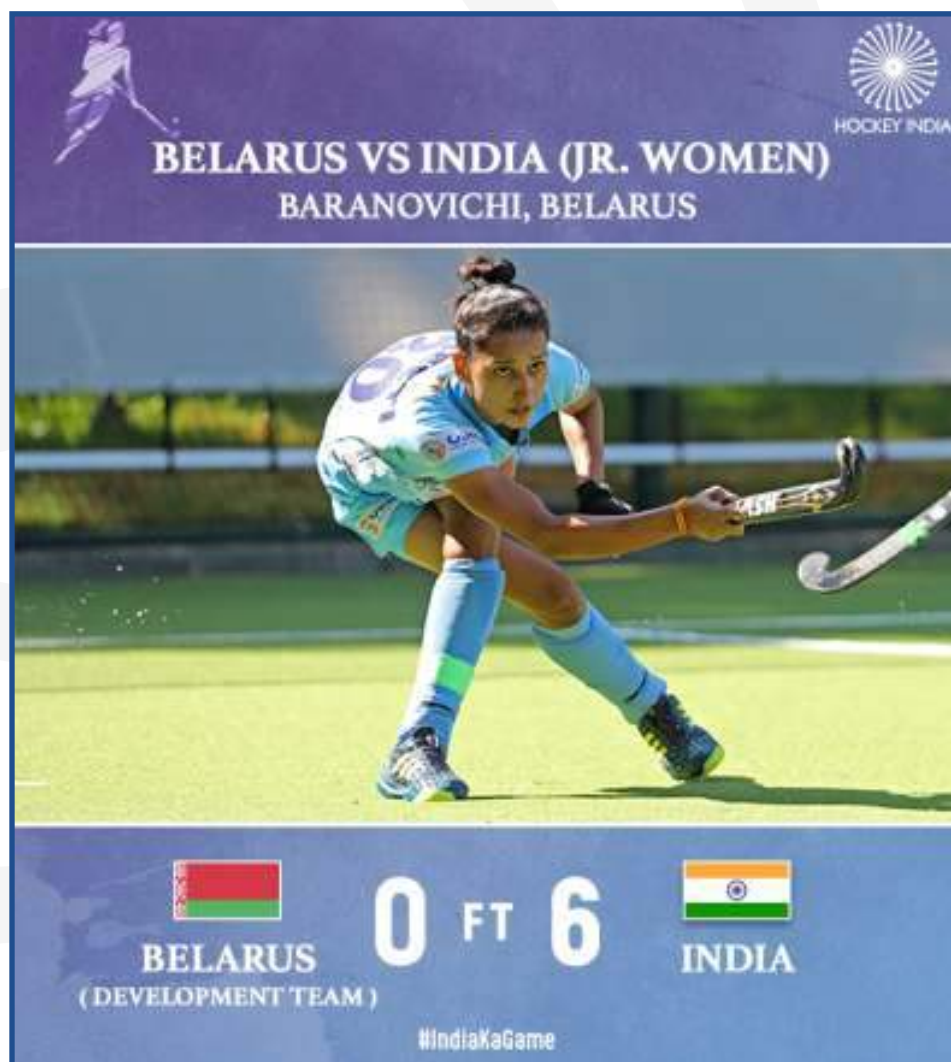

## HOCKEY INDIA NAMED GRAHAM REID AS THE CHIEF COACH OF THE INDIAN MEN'S HOCKEY TEAM



Reid has a decorated playing career as the defender/ midfielder for the Australian National team and was part of the Silver Medal winning team at the 1992 Barcelona Olympics. He was also part of the Australian squad that won back-to-back Champions Trophy titles in 1984, 1985 and 1989, 1990. With 130 International Caps, Reid took to Coaching a national team when he was appointed Assistant Coach in 2009 for Australia. During this tenure he was elevated to the Head Coach position and he guided the Australian team to their fifth consecutive Champions Trophy title in 2012.

He was named Head Coach in 2014 where he contributed to Australian squad's reign as world No.1 team. Under his guidance, they won the World League Semi Final in Antwerp and went on to win the World League Final in Raipur the same year. A member of the Queensland Hockey Hall of Fame, Reid moved to the Netherlands in 2017 to serve as the Head Coach of Amsterdam Club which he was part of as a player in 1993 and 1994. In his recent stint, he worked as the Assistant Coach for the Netherlands team who won the Silver Medal at the 2018 Men's World Cup.
